

# CSP Perio-Hygiene Collaborative Seminar Saturday August 5, 2023 4.0 Hours C.E.

#### **Periodontal Regeneration**

This course will discuss what is periodontal regeneration and what outcomes can be expected along with identifying which sites are good candidates for periodontal regeneration. The course will also review the basic principles of guided tissue regeneration (GTR) and discuss the limitations of regenerative periodontal medicine.

## Dental Implants, Maintenance and Peri-implantitis

This course will discuss common dental implant prosthetics and which instruments are recommended for use on abutments and implant protocol for maintenance. This course will also review the etiology of peri-implantitis and how to manage it with surgical and non-surgical treatment strategies. Clinical cases will be reviewed.
